TEMPORARY ASSIGNMENT TO COUNTY AND CIRCUIT COURT

WHEREAS the Honorable Ben Bryan, Jr. served as a circuit judge in St. Lucie County from January 1, 2008 to January 5, 2009 in the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit of Florida.

WHEREAS during his last assignment, Judge Bryan handled, among other cases, certain county criminal, circuit criminal and/or circuit civil hearings and trials.

WHEREAS when Judge Bryan retired effective January 6, 2009 there were orders concerning hearings and trials wherein Judge Bryan sat as the circuit judge that had not been reduced to writing and therefore not signed by him but were concerning such cases were he had ruled orally from the bench.

WHEREAS these orders have now been presented for signing to the Circuit Court of the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit, St. Lucie County, Florida, for the Honorable Ben Bryan Jr.'s perusal and signature.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

The Honorable Ben Bryan, Jr. is hereby authorized, pursuant to state law, to sign orders, nunc pro tunc to the date of his oral pronouncement, on those cases that he specifically ruled from the bench and for the purpose of considering and executing all orders regarding hearings and trials wherein he sat as a circuit and/or county judge during the time period of January 1, 2008 through January 5, 2009.
