

CASE MANAGEMENT HEARINGS

If a case management order is desired, it can be handled in one of two ways. Either a case management hearing can be coordinated with opposing counsel for a specially set time by contacting Judge Conner's Judicial Assistant, or a stipulated order can be submitted to the court. There is no need to set a hearing asking the court to set a case management hearing unless the parties cannot agree on a date for the case management hearing.

Any deadlines for pre-trial procedures set by a case management order supersede and control over the court's standard order setting pre-trial procedure entered when the notice for trial is filed.
