

SPECIAL SET MOTIONS

(Motions Requiring More Than 10 Minutes of Hearing Time)

Motion(s) Requiring More Than 10 Minutes – Up to One Hour: If you have a motion or multiple motions that are not appropriate for UMC Calendars (because the motion(s) require more than 10 minutes) and you need up to one hour of hearing time, please call Lynn T. Atkinson, Judge Conner’s Judicial Assistant, at (772) 462-1460 to obtain dates and times to coordinate with opposing counsel.

Once hearing time is scheduled with Judge Conner’s Judicial Assistant, you may not add motions to the hearing time without the agreement of opposing counsel. Whatever time is scheduled for the case on Judge Conner’s calendar is all the time that will be allotted for the case, and Judge Conner does use a timer. Make sure enough time is scheduled to hear whatever motions are noticed for hearing.

Motion(s) Requiring More Than One Hour: If you have a motion or multiple motions that require more than one hour of hearing time, you must file a request that the court place your case on the next available Calendar Call. At Calendar Call the court will schedule your motion(s) for hearing as time permits.
