CASE TRACKING
It is your responsibility to track your case position on the Trial Docket. **Do not call the Judicial Assistant for updates on the Trial Dockets or Jury Selection or Trials Dates; all are posted on the website for your convenience.** Unless you have received an order to the contrary or you have been advised by the court/J.A., you must appear when your case is scheduled for Jury Selection even if the case(s) ahead of you advise that it/they are definitely going to trial.

MUTUALLY AGREEABLE TRIAL DATES
Please check the court's monthly calendars (online) for actual trial weeks. The parties should attempt to discuss mutually agreeable trial dates before attending Docket Call.

CASE SETTLEMENT

If a case settles, Plaintiff's Counsel **must** email or fax a voluntary dismissal or letter advising the Court of same prior to the trial date so that the case may be removed from the calendar. If you do not email or fax a letter of settlement and you do not appear for the weekly trial docket call, your case will be dismissed. If your case is dismissed, please advise the Judicial Assistant by email or fax so that she may remove the case from the Trial Docket, simply filing with the Clerk does not remove your case from the Docket Call Docket or Weekly Trial Calendar.
