**ORDER SETTING CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

The Court finds that it is in the best interests of the parties to provide for the prompt and efficient administration of Justice. Upon the Court's own initiative, after receipt of a Notice for Trial, and pursuant to Rule 12.200, Fla. Fam. L. R. P., a Case Management Conference is ordered by the Court and will be held in the above captioned matter before the **CIRCUIT JUDGE ROBERT MAKEMSON** on \_\_\_\_\_ in courtroom "A1-3" of the Martin County Courthouse, Stuart, Florida. Both parties and their counsel are required to attend this conference.

Failure of a party to attend the Case Management Conference may result in the dismissal of this action, striking of pleadings, limitation of proof or witnesses, or other appropriate action by the Court. Upon special circumstances, the Court may allow parties to appear at the Case Management Conference by telephone; **all requests to appear by telephone must be made in writing and received by the Judge's office no later than five (5) days before the Case Management Conference is scheduled.** If you do not obtain the Court's permission to appear by phone in advance of the date set for Case Management Conference, **you must appear in person, and with your attorney, if you are represented.**

At the conference, the Court may schedule or reschedule evidentiary matters; schedule, order, or expedite discovery; schedule disclosure of expert witnesses and discovery of facts known; schedule motions related to the admission or exclusion of evidence; pursue the possibilities of settlement; require the filing of preliminary stipulations if issues can be narrowed; refer parties to mediation; refer the cause for a home study or psychological evaluation; and schedule other conferences or determine other matters that may aid in the disposition of the action. If full settlement has been reached, and the matter is uncontested and all requirements have been met, the case may proceed to Final Hearing on this date.
