ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2020-09

IN RE: COVID-19 Resumption of Certain Proceedings

WHEREAS in AO2020-01 mitigating measures were instituted as necessary to address the effects of COVID-19, including:

subsection (6) suspension of civil and traffic cases;

subsection (7) suspension of county ordinance violations;

subsection (8) suspension of foreclosure sales;

subsection (11) suspension of problem-solving court proceedings;

WHEREAS the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit is now beginning its phased reopening of court proceedings, pursuant to AO2020-06, A02020-07 and AOSC20-32 *Amendment 2*;

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Effective June 1, 2020, the above suspensions are hereby lifted, and the matters may proceed, provided they are conducted in conformity with any Administrative Orders of the Florida Supreme Court and are consistent with AO2020-07. In A02020-07, Judges were directed to continue to maximize remote work by Zoom or other electronic means to limit the number of in-person court appearances and thereby reduce the risks of COVID-19 exposure to all persons involved in court proceedings after May 30, 2020.
