PER CURIAM.

The documents in this case's paper only record are hopelessly in conflict, and the discrepancies in the critical facts were unexplained. *See Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles v. Trimble*, 821 So. 2d 1084, 1086 (Fla. 1st DCA 2002); *McClelland v. State of Florida, Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles*, 18-AP-5 (19th Cir.-Martin Jul. 10, 2018); *Larroude v. State of Florida, Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles*, 18-AP-11 (19th Cir.-Indian River Nov. 6, 2018). Therefore, the hearing officer's order was not supported by competent substantial evidence.

The petition for writ of certiorari is granted, and the hearing officer's order is quashed.
