ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2022-07

RE: Calendar Year 2023 Court Holidays

In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge pursuant to Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215, it is hereby ORDERED:

The following holidays will be observed by the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit for the calendar year 2023:

New Year's Day (Observed)	Monday, January 2, 2023
Martin Luther King Day	Monday, January 16, 2023
Good Friday*	Friday, April 7, 2023
Memorial Day	Monday, May 29, 2023
Independence Day	Tuesday, July 4, 2023
Labor Day	Monday, September 4, 2023
Yom Kippur*	Monday, September 25, 2023
Veterans' Day (Observed)	Friday, November 10, 2023
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 23, 2023
Friday after Thanksgiving	Friday, November 24, 2023
Christmas Eve (Observed)**	Friday, December 22, 2023
Christmas Day	Monday, December 25, 2023


This holiday schedule is identical to the holiday schedule established by the Supreme Court of Florida for calendar year 2023. In accordance with the State Courts System Personnel Regulation 4.07(1) if a legal holiday falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as a holiday. If a legal holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be observed as a holiday. Therefore, New Year's Day is observed on Monday, January 2, 2023 and Veterans' Day is observed on Friday, November 10, 2023. Furthermore, in accordance with State Courts System Personnel Regulation 4.07(2) one additional workday may be designated as a discretionary holiday. As such, Friday, December 22, 2023, is selected as a discretionary holiday for Nineteenth Judicial Circuit officers and employees.

**Denotes a discretionary holiday designated by the Chief Judge in accordance with State Courts System Personnel Regulation 4.07(2).

On holiday(s) designated by the counties within the Nineteenth Judicial Circuit: The court in the respective county will remain open for court employees to conduct work; however, court events will not be scheduled on these days.
