The parties should attempt to discuss mutually agreeable trial dates before attending Docket Call.</p>
<p align="center"><u>CASE TRACKING</u></p> <p>If a case settles, Plaintiff’s counsel must email a letter advising the Court of same prior to the trial date so that the case may be removed from the trial calendar. If you do not email a letter of settlement and you do not appear for weekly calendar call, your case will be dismissed. If your case is dismissed, please advise the JA by email so she may remove the case from the Trial Docket.
